 6. Pray that God will make your heart open to joining Pioneer Bible Translators team in Papua New Guinea as a technical service person (repair and construction) or joining Team Cox in Ethiopia representing Fifth Ave. Christian Church and God's Kingdom worldwide. Who is to say you can't go?
