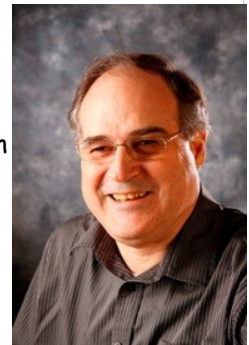

DEAR FRIENDS,

At the moment I am near the end of 4 days in HONG KONG. Later today I will have a meeting to collect information for a final report on our IDES WATER PROJECT FOR SICHUAN EARTHQUAKE VICTIMS. I have been able to slow down a bit while here in Hong Kong, after 3 months of very hectic non-stop schedules. You might recall that our pastor in Navotas suddenly resigned in March, effectively doubling my load for April and May, especially. Two mission trips with students from Navotas were already planned and we pushed through with them, along with Vacation Bible School in 5 churches. My planned 3 week trip to China was cut back to these 4 days in Hong Kong. **GOD IS SO FAITHFUL! BY HIS GRACE** I had the strength finish all these special programs and at the same time devote myself to keeping the ministry in Navotas on track.



PRAISE REPORTS.

1. **MISSION TEAMS:** I led 2 TEAMS OF 7 PEOPLE EACH to help with outreach in our BICOL churches (San Jose, Caramoan, and Ragay). We conducted A 3-DAY KIDS CAMP for 150 in Caramoan along with various services, film showings and evangelistic activities everywhere. Not only did we have an effective ministry in Bicol, overcoming many barriers, the testimony of the team members to our home church in Navotas GREATLY ENCOURAGED US.
2. **DAILY VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL (DVBS):** Overall in our churches in Navotas, Malabon, Ragay, San Jose and Caramoan, we had nearly 700 CHILDREN PARTICIPATING. We pray that the seeds of faith planted in these children will not only grow in their individual lives in the years to come, but that roots will be set into all of their families.
3. **UNITY AND STRENGTH IN THE NAVOTAS CHURCH:** The leaders of the Navotas church have really worked hard to maintain unity in this time of adjustment after our pastor's departure. The church is doing well. We had a CHURCH FAMILY OUTING last Sunday with 210 attending. Please pray us as we continue to make adjustments, and especially for the time that I will be in the U.S. beginning June 22.

I have decided to push through with my planned trip to the U.S. June 22 - September 19. The following
