It has been a little over three weeks since I announced my candidacy for Senate District 17, and I thought it might be a good idea to review some of the things I shared from the pulpit that morning.

GOD IS AT WORK UPSTREAM: At the completion of the Daniel fast in November, I received an e-mail from Taylor Brown, from Northern Ag Network, asking me to consider running for the open seat of Senate District 17. (This district runs from the motherland of Turner to west of Havre.). Taylor wrote, “Sometimes you pick the time, and sometimes the time picks you.

I then met with the Board and asked them to pray about this decision. We then met two weeks later and the Board unanimously agreed to allow me to pursue the senate.

On January 14th I filed to run for Senate District 17.

I have every intention of continuing to lead this congregation to new heights in the area of reaching the lost, global missions, and discipleship. My prayer is that I will represent this area with Integrity, but more importantly I will represent Jesus and His Kingdom.

Sue and I are at a point in our lives where we will soon be empty nesters, and Sue will be able to travel with me as often as she desires.
